The list of victims of Iranian regime state terrorism in Iraqi Kurdistan in 1990 to 1997

For more than three decades, the Islamic Republic of Iran has been a source and promoter of state terrorism in the Middle East and beyond. Since its establishment in 1979, the regime has widely resorted to the terrifying militancy of the Shia and fundamentalist faith and the fanaticism of the children of the 'Islamic Revolution' determined to use force to eliminate the regime's political opponents. To be more precise, the Islamic regime used its immense oil revenue to convince all Islamic groups in the region to share the belief that the elimination of the *aghyar* (a foreigner or stranger), at the individual or group level, is an important form of Jihad and holy war.

Means and sources were therefore used in the service of this doctrine and in doing so rendered noble, in a number of ways. The Islamic republic had not only detained, imprisoned, tortured and executed its opponents on a mass scale during the past three decades in Iran, but it also used its resources to operate the terror groups outside of Iran, including in capital and major cities of European countries so as even those who have fled Iran and sought asylum abroad could not be sure of their safety.

During the past three decades, agents of the Iranian governments have assassinated dozens of Iranian political activists resettled as political refugees abroad. One clear example is the *Mykonos* terror. The attack was one of a series of assassinations designed to intimidate and disrupt the activities of political opponents of the Islamic Republic. Let's remind ourselves what happened at the late evening, 17th September, 1992. In that fall day a group of Iranian exiles are gathered in a Berlin restaurant, *Mykonos*, to meet a prominent Kurdish leader of KDP, Dr. Sadegh Sharafkandi. At 10:47 p.m. that September 17th, two masked men burst into the restaurant and fired at the group sitting around a table in the back room, killing Dr. Sharafkandi and two colleagues and wounding several others in a hail of bullets. The killings had sparked a diplomatic crisis. The *Mykonos* assassinations created headlines around the world, which led therefore to the arrest and trial of several *Mykonos* perpetrators.

One impact of *Mykonos* was that no one can any longer afford to keep silent towards the policy of Islamic terror in capitals and major cities of Western countries. Today, the impact of the Islamic republic and its state terrorism in the Middle East and beyond may be relatively grasped by a considerable number of individuals. However, until recent years the phenomenon did not attract serious attention. We believe that it was a combination of ignorance and their political and trade dealings with Iran that led European countries, despite their diametrically opposed views of the Islamist groups, to fall into an Islamic republic trap, and turn a blind eye to the state terrorism of the Islamic republic.

Despite all this, until now the terrifying state of terror and insecurity that the Islamic republic of Iran created in Iraqi Kurdistan, against the political opponents in general, and Kurdish party members' in particular in the 1990s, remains obscure. The limited resources of the Kurdish oppositional parties were compounded by failure of the

Western mass media to adequately inform people about this crime against humanity. As a result even the rudimentary semiotics of this open and organised daily politico-religious violence, and assassination of political activists, remains unknown to Western policymakers and human rights activists. In addition to the assassination of dozens Iranian oppositional leaders and personalities in Western countries, the Islamic republic terror groups have carried out hundreds of terror missions inside Iraqi Kurdistan. Although the exact number of victims of the Islamic regime terror can only be finalized when there is access to all information and achieves of all concerned parties, however our records reveal that during this period **217** Kurdish political activists have been assassinated, a further **6** out of **8** activists were kidnapped executed, and a further **57** activists were ambushed, shot and severely injured.

These days U.S. and European policymakers often express their support for the rights of the Iranians, including national minorities, and acknowledge that safeguarding these rights should be seen as a big step in the process of establishing a future democratic Iran. However, given differing U.S. human rights policies for Bahrain, Egypt, Libya, Saudi Arabia, Syria, and Iran, we may add that more consistency in promoting human rights in the region, would in fact be better served in European countries. We here publish the names of victims of the terrifying impact of the Islamic republic terror in the Iraqi Kurdistan in the 1990s. This crime against humanity remains unknown so far, and we hope therefore you support us in our attempt to bring the perpetrators of this crime to justice.

Following a wide range efforts at the international level made by our and after the pressure imposed on the regime by some organisations and political personalities as well as philanthropist foundations so that the destiny of the said six prisoners could be clarified eventually, the then ambassador of the Islamic Regime in Britain in a letter to Mr. Jeremy Corbyn, Labour MP for Islington North and the vice president of Human Rights Group of The British parliament, dated 29/03/2004, had thrown some lights on the execution of the aforementioned six members of the Party. In a written answer, Islamic ambassador has attributed the execution of these members to the Islamic Movement, and claimed that the said six men had been killed in a battle with "the Islamic Movement" organisation when they were returning to the Iranian Kurdistan.
